The Cert III in Individual Support trains students to work as a carer in community and residential settings, caring for people who need additional support due to age, living with disability, or other reasons. Graduates learn to work with diverse clients safely and ethically, providing tailored care and supporting the person's wellbeing and independence. The course has two possible streams - Disability or Ageing - each of which offers its own specialised training, work opportunities, and career paths.

- Must participate in Suitability Interview
- Must be competent in written and spoken English, numeracy, and digital literacy (Solis College may require an LLN test to verify this)
- Must hold or be able to get (as required):

## Certificate IV in Disability Support CHC43121

The Cert IV in Disability Support prepares students to work in the disability industry, supporting people living with disability in a range of circumstances. Students learn to improve community participation and social inclusion, help clients with complex needs and mental health issues, and respond to crisis situations. Graduates are trained to work without the need for direct supervision, and can support other care workers and manage small teams.

The Ageing Support course trains students to work in residential, home, or community-based aged-care settings. Students learn to perform specialised aged care tasks as well as directly caring for clients. Students learn to help clients toward better independence, encourage connections with family and community, and provide support for palliative care. Graduates are capable of working independently, and can lead small teams or provide support for other staff.




